“Hugo McCloud: Metal Paintings” Sean Kelly BK (420b Troutman Street) CLOSES: March 18 The artist and the gallery have transformed an industrial space in Brooklyn’s Bushwick neighborhood into the temporary Sean Kelly BK to host this special exhibition (on view March 17 and 18 from 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.). In creating this new body of work, the artist puts aside the more colorful approach for which he’s known in order to incorporate the techniques and materials— scrap metal, solder, chemical patinas, and welding—that he experimented with earlier in his career. The series is at once an exciting return, and departure, for the artist.
